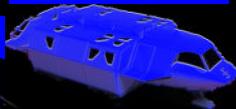
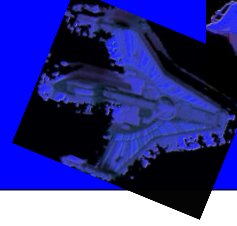

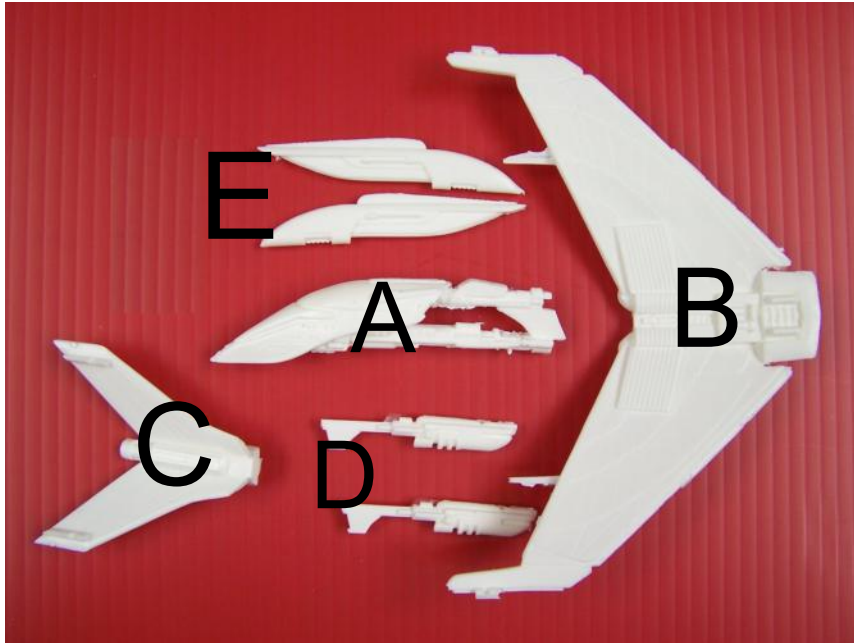

D'Ronex

Parts List:

You should have 7 parts. 2 laser cannons, 2 engines, 1 head/neck ,
1 lower body cannon mount and the main body.



Step 1.

Locate part 'A' (head/neck) and part 'B' (body). The neck is cemented to the main body by aligning the slot in the upper neck to the wing space between the baffle plates. Make certain you have the wing and neck orientated as shown.



Step 2.

Locate part 'C' and 'B' which should have the head/neck attached. Cement Part 'C' to the underside of the D'Ronex body, paying attention to the orientation. The wings should point forward and down similar to the main body. See photo.



Step 3. (2x)

Locate parts 'D' and 'C' which should now be the body, neck/head and lower wings as one piece cemented together.

Parts 'D' are cemented to the small lower wing, paying attention to the orientation. The cannons have a small tab to help with alignment (see photo).



Step 4. (2x)

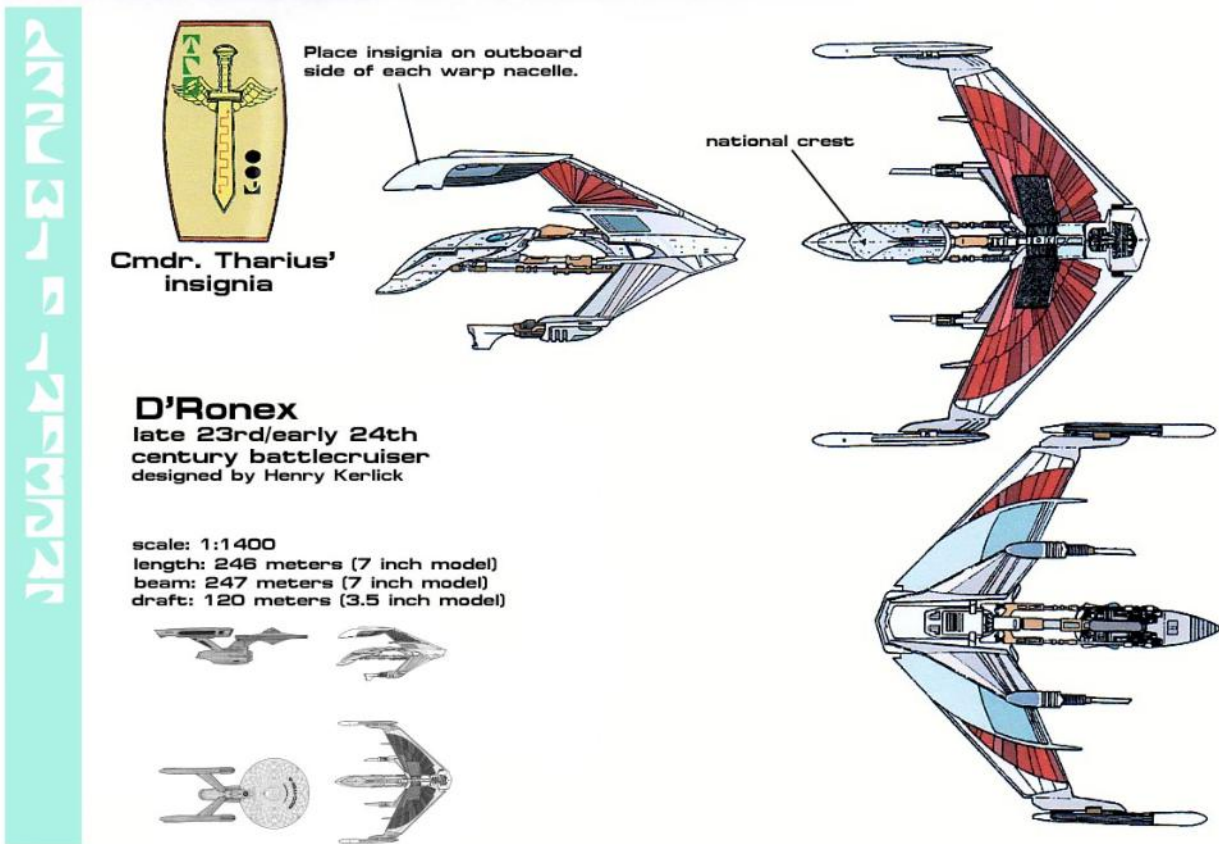
Locate part 'E' and 'C' which should now have the laser cannons cemented in place. Cement parts "E" to the upper wing, paying attention to the orientation (see photo).



Painting.

D'Ronex Class Battlecruiser

By 2270 the Klolode class cruisers which the Romulans had acquired from their Klingon allies were rapidly becoming obsolete. New designs were urgently needed to counter the Federation's new Constitution II class starships and the advances of the increasingly restive Klingon Empire.

Using some Klingon assistance, the Romulans designed two new ship classes: a small warship designed for scouting and commerce raiding, and a large battlecruiser. The Klingons immediately saw the potential of the cruiser, and acquired an incomplete prototype from the Romulans. The Klingon/Romulan alliance ended before the battlecruiser design was completed; upon completion, the new cruiser went into full production with the Romulan Star Empire. They named it the D'Ronex (Bloodhawk) class.

The D'Ronex would soon see action against the Romulan's erstwhile allies – the Klingons – as well as the Federation's Starfleet. They fought well in these encounters, but were chiefly employed for the next forty years against an enemy on the Romulan's coreward borders: The Husnock. The D'Ronex would spearhead the Empire's desperate struggle against that invading power. These ships were often upgraded with additional deflector plating during the war. The conflict ended abruptly in 2367 when the entire Husnock species suddenly vanished. By that time the D'Ronex class had long since been decommissioned.

The D'Ronex is also noteworthy as the chosen starship of Commander Tharius, one of the most famous – or infamous – officers in Romulan history. His defense of Xivir IX against a Klingon taskforce is universally studied today. His chilling motto was: "Killing barbarians isn't ones' duty; it's ones' pleasure."
